by Chris Priestly**

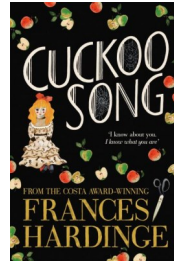

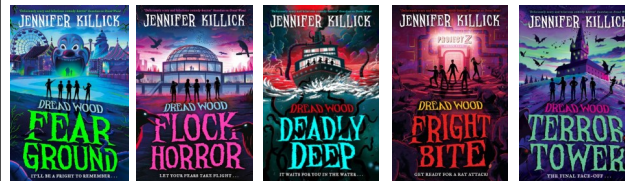
**Dread Wood

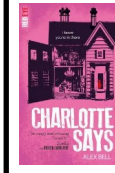

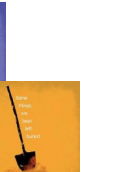
**The Red Eye series  
by Various Authors**



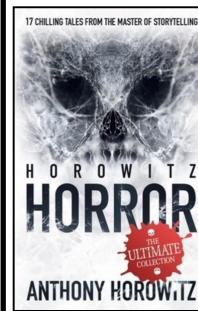

A quaint country cottage that has a grisly secret. A man returns from holiday with bubbling skin and bloodshot eyes.

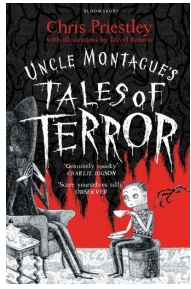

**by Will Hill**

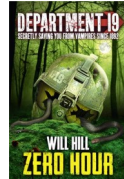
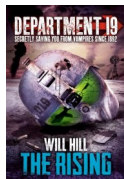
